About the Examinations

Associate Safety Professional (ASP)

The ASP (often called CSP Safety Fundamentals exam) is the first test required in the two-test process of becoming a CSP. The test consists of 200 questions designed to measure the academic knowledge expected of the entry-level safety professional.

<u>Certified Safety Professional (CSP)</u>

The CSP Exam is the second-level examination in the two test process.

This examination consists of 200 questions that examine the candidate's applied knowledge and the application of experience gained through professional practice. Both the ASP and the CSP are administered by the BCSP.

Applicants must have a college degree and four years of professional safety experience.

Construction Health and Safety Technician (CHST)

The CHST is a certification dedicated to construction safety principles and practices. It is designed for practitioners who fill job site safety positions on construction projects. This certification does not require a college degree.

Safety Trained Supervisor Construction (STS)

The STS certification provides a means for employers to verify safety and health knowledge of first-line managers. The program requires applicants to meet minimum education and experience requirements and demonstrate knowledge of basic safety and health standards and practices.
