The Level 1A Fundamental Seminar is a oneday course ending with the Level 1A certification exam. The course is designed to train contractors, builders, developers, site superintendents, utility and grading contractors, and monitor consultants in the proper installation, maintenance, and inspection of BMP's on construction sites.

Topics covered in this course are fundamentals of erosion and sediment control; the Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act; NPDES Permits; maintenance; stream buffers; and vegetative and structural BMP practices.
