NPDES Level 1A Fundamentals Certification (Blue Card)

The Level 1A Fundamental Seminar and exam is a one-day course ending with the Level 1A certification exam. The course is designed to train contractors, builders, developers, site superintendents, utility and grading contractors, and monitor consultants in the proper installation, maintenance, and inspection of BMP's on construction sites.

Topics covered in this course are fundamentals of erosion and sediment control, the Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act, NPDES Permits, maintenance, stream buffers, and vegetative and structural BMP practices.

CPR, First Aid and Bloodborne Pathogens

CPR/First Aid/Bloodborne Pathogens course is an American Safety and Health Institute program consisting of three modules:

Adult Heart Saver: Includes information about the chain of survival concepts, risk factors, prudent heart living, signals for 911 activation, adult-one rescuer CPR and Foreign Body Airway Obstruction.

First Aid: This course covers video and guided discussion presentations covering signs, symptoms, and treatments of common medical and traumatic emergencies.

Bloodborne Pathogens: Topics of this module include definition, prevention, universal precautions, immunization, exposure control, and post-exposure reporting.

OSHA 30-Hour for Construction

Many owners and general contractors are now requiring that contractors complete the OSHA 30-Hour Construction Safety Outreach course prior to working on their projects. The class is OSHA's main method of training site workers and management.

This four-day course is a comprehensive safety program designed for anyone in the construction industry. It is developed for the person who works with a broad variety of construction standards. The class covers the full spectrum of construction safety from Subpart A through Subpart Z. Learn how to recognize basic construction hazards and implement corrective measures through classroom instruction.

Upon successful course completion, attendees will receive an OSHA 30-Hour Construction Outreach Course completion card.

OSHA's Crystalline Silica Competent Person Training for Construction

December 20 ♦ Atlanta

Exposure to respirable crystalline silica can cause silicosis, lung cancer, other respiratory diseases and kidney disease. About two million construction workers are exposed in over 600,000 workplaces. OSHA estimates more than 840,000 workers are exposed to silica levels that exceed the new permissible exposure limit. Workers and contractors need to recognize the hazard, understand the risk factors and work safety silica. The new rule mandates that all construction employers covered by the standard to have written exposure control plan designate a competent person. This course will provide supervisors, managers and safety professionals the knowledge and tools to comply with the new silica standard for construction. Attendees will also receive the information needed to serve as silica competent persons, in order to implement the written exposure control plan required by the standard.

OSHA 10-Hour for Construction

OSHA requires a contractor to have a competent person on-site to qualify for Focused Inspection. This safety course is designed to help contractors develop safety and health competent persons for their job sites. The competent person will learn to recognize potential hazards in construction before an incident occurs. Plus, individuals will be able to identify and implement abatement techniques for hazards found on the construction site.
