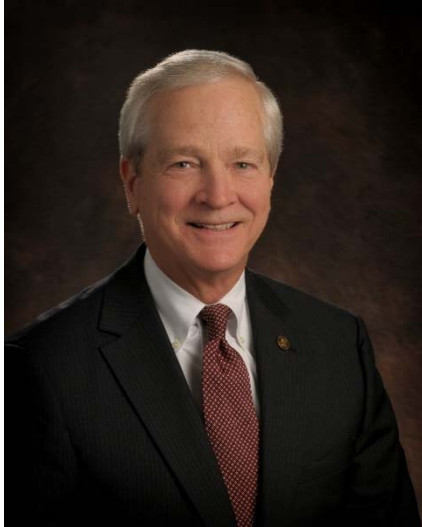

**Title: The Changing Role of the General Contractor in

The role of the general contractor has changed significantly in the last 20 years. Contracting expertise is now being introduced into projects early during design requiring a different approach to establishing construction prices.
