26 YEARS OF GREAT FISHING, GOLF AND TALL TALES!

In 1985, Chapter member **Jerry Anderson**, *Anderson Construction Company*, invited members to his "backyard" in Eufaula, AL & Fort Gaines, GA for a weekend of fishing and a pig roast. Attendees agreed to make the event an annual fishing and eating weekend! In 1989, Bagby State Park opened in Fort Gaines, allowing out-of-town participants more options for lodging, thus the following for the event significantly increased. At the same time, the Georgia membership asked Alabama AGC if they would join an annual Largest Bass Fishing Challenge with the winner taking home a revolving trophy. Alabama agreed and offered to pay for half the trophy . . . *they have since won the majority of the tournaments and never paid half of the trophy!*



In the 1990s, Georgia Branch, AGC began offering a golf tournament for members who would rather golf than fish, but still enjoy the fellowship in small town America and the weekend's great Southern cooking. Over the past two decades, the event's venue has changed, the BBQ is now slow cooked in a smoker, the fishing stories have gotten bigger, and the golf has is now quite competitive, but the close knit relationships built over this relaxed weekend and the home town hospitality offered by the Anderson Construction Company crew have remained!

WEEKEND EVENTS

Friday's Welcome Reception: Mike Dunham will once again don the chef's apron and prepare his traditional Friday night "Louisiana Fish Fry." Mike grew up in Cajun country, and with his father carefully watching over his chef duties, together they prepare this anticipated meal. The evening gives all participants a chance to visit over great food, cold libations, and music.

Saturday's Breakfast, Fishing & Golfing Tournaments: Before dawn, fishermen and golfers can take advantage of the breakfast available at the lodge. The fishermen take to Lake Walter F. George at day break trying to beat the efforts of the Alabama fisherman who spend Friday on the lake. Golfers meet at Meadowlinks Golf Course for some friendly competition.



Saturday Evening: After the fish weigh-in, follow the aroma of the slow cooked BBQ and enjoy the evening's "South Georgia Luau," presented by the Anderson Construction Company's cooking crew. These master cooks smoke the meats all day, and fix enough to feed all of Clay County. Prizes for both the Fishing and Golf Tournaments are awarded at the evening's awards ceremony.

FISHING TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Pick your own partner; only two fishermen per boat, one of which must be an AGC member. Each participant is responsible for his own safety equipment and license.
2. Prizes are awarded for the highest total weight of large mouth bass caught per boat. Five (5) fish limit per boat – Largemouth Bass and Spotted Bass only). Bass must be at least 14 inches in length, except for Spotted Bass which must be at least 12 inches in length). *Note:* Alabama and Georgia laws state you cannot possess a bass from Lake Eufaula/Lake Walter F. George that is less than these limits.
3. Fishing to begin at your convenience Saturday morning.
4. Artificial bait only and no trolling allowed.
5. Approved life vest to be worn while boat is in operation.
6. Consumption of intoxicants limited to sobriety.
7. Fish weigh-in between 5:00 – 5:30 p.m. Eastern Time at the State Park boat launch near the Marina.
8. Georgia or Alabama fishing license required.
