2019 Legislative Session Results: *The Good, The Bad and The Ugly*

Mark Woodall, AGC Georgia's Director of Governmental Affairs, is visiting with members across the state to share the *good, the bad and the ugly...* and how new laws and regulations from the 2019 legislative session affect you and your company.

A core principle of the entire AGC organization is "less government is better." Our primary legislative agenda is to always play defense against many well-intended proposals that can lead to bad public policy.

This year's session was the first of a two-year legislative process, meaning all bills in play this year but not reaching the Governor's desk for approval are still eligible for consideration when a new session of the General Assembly convenes in January 2020.



On May 6, 2019, AGC Georgia members Doug Tabeling with Smith Currie & Hancock, Dan Baker with Duffey Southeast and Jonathan Barden, Tebarco Mechanical Corporation joined our own Mike Dunham and Mark Woodall, along with Chandler Carter of ACEC and Nathan Humphrey of NFIB for a signing ceremony with Governor Brian Kemp and bill sponsor Representative Kevin Tanner. The group celebrated the signing of AGC Georgia's #1 legislative priority, HB 493 which focused on Private Plan Review & Inspections.

AGC Georgia had a very successful year, providing meaningful input on behalf of the construction industry as we successfully helped push through many pro-construction legislative proposals/ measures. Maybe more importantly, we helped stop of bills that could have negatively impacted the construction industry and business community.

Some of the key legislative proposals AGC Georgia was intimately involved in that made their way to the Governor's desk for approval included

- HB 493 – Private Construction Plan Review and Inspections
- HB 322 – Georgia Department of Administrative Services (DOAS) Procurement Registry
- HB 31 – Construction Workforce Development Funding in the 2020 State Appropriations Budget
