Why do people make mistakes? One line of thought assumes people can choose to make errors, and when they do, it is due to willful misconduct. A different line of thought understands all humans make mistakes every day, even every hour. Human error is often identified as cause of many accidents and near events. However, it is the beginning point rather than the end point in truly understanding both accident causation and safety performance.
