**More about the ASC Competition:** In simulations of the real-world general contractor bid and proposal process, student teams interpret bid documents, plan means and methods, perform take-offs and pricing, analyze subcontractor quotes, create schedules, and submit proposals. Teams are evaluated by industry judges on the quality of written proposals and oral presentations, and all within a tight 36-hour period.
