

OSHA Crane Standard Subpart CC: Qualified Signal Persons & Qualified Riggers Safety Training



About the Course

This course meets the requirements of OSHA's Subpart CC - Cranes in Construction regulations. In one day, covers both Qualified Signal Person requirements and Basic Level 1 Qualified Rigger requirements. Many companies currently require documentation of a Qualified Signal Person and Qualified Rigger before allowing you to work on their sites.

Attendees will review standard ANSI hand and voice signals along with basic hitches, capacity calculations and inspection requirements for rigging equipment. Students are required to pass a written and practical exam as required by OSHA.

- Supervisors & personnel who work with or around cranes
- All personnel who signal cranes (Mobile & Tower)
- All personnel who rig loads on cranes
- General contractors who own, rent or oversee mobile or tower cranes on their jobsites
- Employers who own or rent mobile or tower cranes
