Ken is the developer of L3 intervention and founder of the Intervene Challenge. More than 17,000 individuals have participated in the Challenge to turn the *tide on suicide*®.

He is the 2016 Trinity Awards Emergency Responder of the Year and was inducted into the University of North Georgia Alumni Hall of Fame for his work in conducting more than 1,400 suicide interventions in both military and civilian communities. Ken continues to serve as a Chaplain (LTC) in the US Army Reserves.
