This course is the first step on the path to developing construction supervisors and is specifically designed to meet the needs of the learner, as well as the construction industry. CSF focuses on the knowledge, skills and attitudes required for effective construction supervision. It is especially appropriate for those who are new supervisors or newly promoted foremen, or for anyone who seeks career advancement in leading and directing construction activities. The curriculum includes case studies, group activities and provides jobsite exercises for skill development.
