- Learn how to provide support to someone who may be in crisis related t suicidal thoughts & behaviors, a panic attack, or response to a traumatic event.
- Deep dive on crisis related to suicidal thoughts and behaviors and how this type of crisis is addressed on a jobsite.
- Practice powerful evidence based coping strategies to provide others as well as for your own mental wellbeing.
