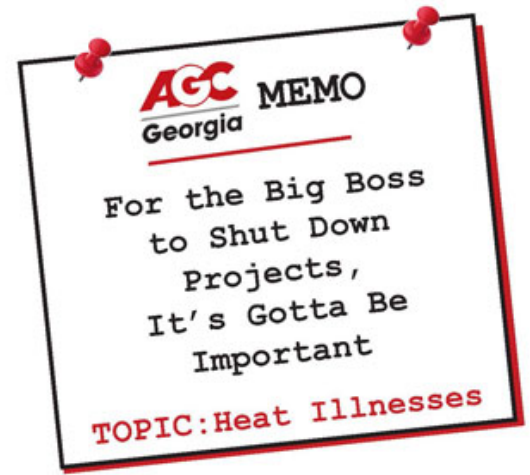


AGC Safety Stand Down on Heat Illnesses
