The number and types of technologies available to construction firms has never been greater. Tablets, cloud computing, BIM and many other resources create value in design and construction delivery, but what about safety? How can apps and programs create a safer jobsite and streamlined reporting?

- **Safesite** Web-based safety management platform
- **Notevault** Voice record safety items and share with team
- **FotoIn** Create custom tags for safety and auto sync to server
- **FieldLens** Create issues and assign to others for correction
- **RMP App** Document safety items and sync to private server
- **iAuditor** Create and share custom safety forms
- **BIM 360 Field** Track safety items to correction through app

Many are IT directors and project managers, others have a personal interest in technology, while many from smaller offices are tapped as the designated IT guru but have no background in the field!
