

At the 2018 AGC of America Annual Convention, the YLP earned an AGC in the Community Award for their efforts on the Bo Baker family home.

In 2017, the construction of the project moved through demolition, framing of new walls, electrical/plumbing rough in work, relocation of HVAC distribution, drywall hanging and finishing, painting, new wood floors, trimp carpentry installation, installation of doors and hardware, re-installation of the salvaged vanity, tile installation, shower panels installation, fixture and trim of plumbing and electrical items. After eight weeks, the team created a therapy room, bedroom and enlarged the bathroom.
