At the 2018 AGC of America Annual Convention, the YLP earned a AGC in the Community Award for their efforts on the Bo Baker family home.



In 2017, the construction of the project moved through demolition, framing of new walls, electrical/plumbing rough in work, relocation of HVAC distribution, drywall hanging and finishing, painting, new wood floors, trimp carpentry installation, installation of doors and hardware, re-installation of the salvaged vanity, tile installation, shower panels installation, fixture and trim of plumbing and electrical items. After eight weeks, the team created a therapy room, bedroom and enlarged the bathroom.
