


Fulfilling A Make-A-Wish Dream

Hillside of Atlanta Renovation

Founded on a mission to help children and families thrive by providing residential and community health services for young individuals, Hillside's continued growth and impact on the community required additional offices and meeting space. As important, the organization needed a welcoming and warm space to initially bring children, in order to get them into a safe environment where therapy could begin. It can be very difficult for families and children to seek help, so it's critical that their initial experience is warm and inviting.

The AGC Georgia YLP has had a long-lasting relationship with Hillside and this project was very important to the organization. The team needed to remodel an outdated home by replacing trim, doors, cabinetry, restroom finishes and fixtures, as well as refinishing floors, and updating the fireplace with custom millwork to serve as a focal point.

Along with Hillside's amazing facilities group, YLP was able to accomplish all these updates by providing monetary aid, donated materials, and on-site labor to handle painting, plumbing, and electrical. We enjoyed being a part of this project and wish Hillside continued success as they make a significant impact on families and children.
