YLP Council

The YLP Council is composed of YLP members.

It directs and manages the program by working closely with AGC Georgia staff to plan and implement yearly activities. Council members are appointed to serve staggered three year terms. The length of the terms provides members with unique leadership experiences, as well as continuity for the program.

Each year, a new Chair and Vice Chair are named to lead the Council. The Vice Chair from the previous year moves into the Chair position and a new Vice Chair is selected. Both the YLP Chair and Vice Chair serve on the AGC Georgia Board of Directors and report on YLP activities. The full Board provides guidance and direction to YLP as needed.
